## Protection of the Sea (Shipping Levy Collection) Regulations

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council and in pursuance of section 4 of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901*, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Protection of the Sea (Shipping Levy Collection) Act 1981*.

### Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Protection of the Sea (Shipping Levy Collection) Regulations.

### Interpretation

2. In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears, "the Act" means the *Protection of the Sea (Shipping Levy Collection) Act 1981*.

### Service of notice requiring an amount to be paid on account of levy

3. For the purposes of sub-section 8 (3) of the Act, the manner of service of a notice on the master of a ship is—

- (a) by serving the notice on him personally; or
- (b) by sending the notice to him by post addressed to him at the ship.
