Registration of Deaths Abroad Regulations² (Amendment)

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Registration of Deaths Abroad Act 1984*.

Principal Regulations

1. In these Regulations, "Principal Regulations" means the Registration of Deaths Abroad Regulations.

Fees

2. Regulation 7 of the Principal Regulations is amended:

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) "\$10" and substituting "\$15";
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (b) "\$6" and substituting "\$12".

Schedule 1

3. Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is amended:

- (a) by inserting after item 8 in Form 1 the following item:
"8A Last known occupation";
- (b) by inserting after item 11 in Form 2 the following item:
"11A Last known occupation".

Schedule 2

4. Schedule 2 to the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting after item 7 the following item:

“7A. Last known occupation”.
