1. Amendment

1.1 The Air Navigation (Aircraft Engine Emissions) Regulations are amended as set out in these Regulations.

2. Regulation 9 (Review by Administrative Appeals Tribunal)

2.1 Subregulation 9 (1):

Omit the subregulation, substitute:

- "(1) Subject to the Administrative Appeals Tribunal Act 1975, application may be made to the Administrative Appeals Tribunal for review of a decision of the Secretary or an authorised officer:
 - (a) to refuse to grant, under subregulation 6 (2), a permit; or
 - (b) to impose, under subregulation 6 (3), a condition on a permit; or
 - (c) under subregulation 6 (4)—about:
 - (i) the permitted air navigation specified in a permit; or
 - (ii) the period specified in a permit as the period during which an aircraft may be engaged in a permitted air navigation; or
 - (d) to revoke a permit granted under subregulation 6 (2).".
