## Proceeds of Crime Regulations<sup>2</sup> (Amendment)

### 1. Amendment

1.1 The Proceeds of Crime Regulations are amended as set out in  
these Regulations.

[Note: These Regulations commence on gazettal: see *Acts Interpretation  
Act 1901*, s. 48.]

**2. Regulation 3 (Declaration of State laws—definition of “corresponding law”)****2.1 Paragraph 3 (e):**

Omit the paragraph, substitute:

“(e) *Criminal Assets Confiscation Act 1996* of South Australia;”.

**3. Regulation 4 (Declaration of orders—definition of “interstate forfeiture order”)****3.1 Paragraph 4 (e):**

Omit the paragraph, substitute:

“(e) forfeiture orders made under section 8 or 9 of the *Criminal Assets Confiscation Act 1996* of South Australia;”.

**4. Regulation 5 (Declaration of order—definition of “interstate pecuniary penalty order”)****4.1 New paragraph 5 (da):**

After paragraph 5 (d), insert:

“(da) pecuniary penalty orders under paragraph 9 (4) (b) of the *Criminal Assets Confiscation Act 1996* of South Australia;”.

**5. Regulation 6 (Declaration of orders—definition of “interstate restraining order”)****5.1 Paragraph 6 (e):**

Omit the paragraph, substitute:

“(e) restraining orders under section 15 of the *Criminal Assets Confiscation Act 1996* of South Australia;”.
