#### 5A Vessels

- (1) If:
  - (a) a vessel (the *receiving vessel*) receives fuel from another vessel in the coastal sea; and
  - (b) the fuel has been sold to the operator of the receiving vessel; and
  - (c) the receiving vessel is the end user of the fuel; and
  - the closest land to the receiving vessel is part of a metropolitan area —

the receiving vessel is taken to be in the metropolitan

Note Coastal sea is defined in subsection 15B (4) of the Acts Interpretation Act 1901.

- (2) If:
  - (a) a vessel (the *receiving vessel*) receives fuel from another vessel in the coastal sea; and
  - the fuel has been sold to the operator of the receiving vessel; and
  - the receiving vessel is the end user of the fuel; and
  - (d) the closest land to the receiving vessel is part of a non-metropolitan area —

the receiving vessel is taken to be non-metropolitan area.

Note Coastal sea is defined in subsection 15B (4) of the Acts Interpretation Act 1901.

- (3) If:
  - a vessel (the receiving vessel) receives fuel from (a) another vessel in the coastal sea; and
  - the fuel has been sold to the operator of the receiving vessel; and
  - the receiving vessel is the end user of the fuel; and
  - the closest land to the receiving vessel is part of a remote area ---

the receiving vessel is taken to be in the remote area.

Note Coastal sea is defined in subsection 15B (4) of the Acts Interpretation Act 1901.
