# Horticulture Marketing and Research and Development Services Regulations 2001

Statutory Rules 2001 No. 21

## Part 1 Preliminary

### 1.1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Horticulture Marketing and Research and Development Services Regulations 2001*.

### 1.2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on 1 July 2001.

### 1.3 Definition

In these Regulations:

*Act* means the *Horticulture Marketing and Research and Development Services Act 2000*.

*Note* Part 2 is reserved.

## Part 3 Expenditure and funding of the industry services body

### 3.1 Gross value of production

- (1) For subsection 16 (4) of the Act, the Secretary must determine the amount of gross value of production of the dried fruit sector of the horticultural industry, for a financial year (the *relevant financial year*), by using:

$$\frac{A + B + C}{3}$$

where:

*A* is the estimated value of the dried fruit to be produced in the relevant financial year.

*B* is the value of the dried fruit produced in the financial year immediately before the relevant financial year (the *previous financial year*).

*C* is the value of the dried fruit produced in the financial year immediately before the previous financial year.

- (2) In subregulation (1), a reference to the value of dried fruit produced, or to the estimated value of dried fruit to be produced, in a financial year is a reference to the production figure supplied by the Australian Bureau of Agricultural and Resource Economics that shows:
- the gross value of dried fruit produced by the dried fruit sector of the horticultural industry in that financial year; or
  - the estimated gross value of dried fruit to be produced by the dried fruit sector of the horticultural industry in that financial year.
