REGULATIONS UNDER THE COAL EXCISE ACT 1949-1968.*

AMENDMENT OF THE COAL EXCISE REGULATIONS†

1. Regulation 4 of the Coal Excise Regulations is amended by omitting the words "Two dollars" and inserting in their stead the words "Ten dollars". ^{Licence-} fee.

2. The amendment made by these Regulations has effect in relation to a licence granted or renewed in respect of a period commencing on or after the first day of January, 1970.
