REGULATIONS UNDER THE COAL EXCISE ACT 1949-1968.*

AMENDMENT OF THE COAL EXCISE REGULATIONS†

1. Regulation 4 of the Coal Excise Regulations is amended by omitting the Licencewords "Two dollars" and inserting in their stead the words "Ten dollars".

2. The amendment made by these Regulations has effect in relation to a licence granted or renewed in respect of a period commencing on or after the first day of January, 1970.
