1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Primary Industries (Excise) Levies Amendment Regulations 2002 (No. 1)*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on 1 May 2002.

3 Amendment of *Primary Industries (Excise) Levies Regulations 1999*

Schedule 1 amends the *Primary Industries (Excise) Levies Regulations 1999*.

Schedule 1 Amendments

(regulation 3)

[1] Schedule 3, clause 1

omit

For paragraph 5 (2) (h) of Schedule 3 to the Excise Levies Act,

insert

(1) In this clause:

export licence holder means the holder of a licence granted under section 10 of the *Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry Act 1997*.

(2) For paragraph 5 (2) (h) of Schedule 3 to the Excise Levies Act,

[2] Schedule 3, clause 1*insert*

- (3) Also, if levy is imposed under paragraph 5 (1) (a) of Schedule 3 to the Excise Levies Act on the sale of cattle to an export licence holder (the ***first licence holder***), levy is not imposed on a further sale of the cattle if:
- (a) the sale is to an export licence holder; and
 - (b) the cattle are exported 30 days or less after being acquired by the first licence holder.

[3] Schedule 18, clause 1, before definition of *sale**insert*

export licence holder means the holder of a licence granted under section 10 of the *Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry Act 1997*.

[4] Schedule 18, clause 3*omit*

For paragraph 3 (2) (f) of Schedule 18 to the Excise Levies Act,

insert

- (1) For paragraph 3 (2) (f) of Schedule 18 to the Excise Levies Act,

[5] Schedule 18, clause 3*insert*

- (2) Also, if levy is imposed under paragraph 3 (1) (a) of Schedule 18 to the Excise Levies Act on the sale of live-stock to an export licence holder (the ***first licence holder***), levy is not imposed on a further sale of the live-stock if:
- (a) the sale is to an export licence holder; and
 - (b) the live-stock are exported 30 days or less after being acquired by the first holder.
