**1 Name of Regulations**

These Regulations are the *Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry Amendment Regulations 2002 (No. 4)*. /

**2 Commencement**

These Regulations commence on gazettal.

**3 Amendment of *Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry Regulations 1998***

Schedule 1 amends the *Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry Regulations 1998*.

**Schedule 1 Amendment**

(regulation 3)

**[1] Regulation 3, definition of *quota year***

*substitute*

*quota year* means:

- (a) for sheepmeat and goatmeat exports to the European Union — 1 January to 31 December; or
- (b) for high quality beef exports to the European Union — 1 July to 30 June; or
- (c) for beef exports to the United States of America — 1 January to 31 December.
