1 Name of Regulations

- (b) for 2002 — 1.104;
- (c) for 2003 — 1.104;
- (d) for 2004 — 1.104.

10 Capital number (Act s 106)

For paragraph (b) of the definition of *capital number for the program year* in subsection 106 (1) of the Act, the capital numbers for the following program years are:

- (a) for 2001 — 1.022;
- (b) for 2002 — 1.046;
- (c) for 2003 — 1.046;
- (d) for 2004 — 1.046.
