This Part imposes fees for inspection services in respect of the export of the following goods:

- (a) grains (whether prescribed grains or not);
- (b) horticulture products;
- (c) mung beans;
- (d) plants;
- (e) plant products;
- (f) fish;
- (g) eggs;
- (h) processed fruit or vegetables;
