Amendment - List of Specimens Taken to be Suitable for Live Import – s303EB

I, Ian Gordon Campbell, Minister for the Environment and Heritage, pursuant to paragraph 303EC(1)(a) of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999*, include the following items on Part 1 of the list of specimens taken to be suitable for live import, established under s. 303EB of the EPBC Act, under the heading Vertebrate Animals, Class: Osteichthyes (Bony fishes), in the appropriate alphabetical positions:

<i>Botia lohachata</i> of length 1.5 cm and over	Reticulate loach, Yo-yo loach
<i>Cyphotilapia frontosa</i> of length 12 cm and over	Frontosa, Humphead cichlid
<i>Dekeyseria pulcher</i> of length 1.5 cm and over	Clown peckoltia
<i>Glossolepis incisus</i> of length 1.5 cm and over	Red rainbowfish
<i>Sawbwa resplendens</i> of length 1 cm and over	Burmese rummynose
<i>Yasuhikotakia sidthimunki</i> of length 1.5 cm and over.	Dwarf botia, Skunk loach
