1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the Airports (Control of On-Airport Activities) Amendment Regulations 2005 (No. 1).

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

3 Amendment of Airports (Control of On-Airport Activities) Regulations 1997

[4] Further amendments — LCR Act

The following provisions are amended by omitting 'LC Act' and inserting 'LCR Act':

- regulation 32, definition of *liquor authorisation*
- subregulation 33 (1)
- subregulation 36 (1)
- paragraph 52 (2) (b).
