1 Name of Order [see Note 1]

This Order is the Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry (Standards) Order 2005.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on 1 July 2005.

3 Export of live-stock in accordance with standards

The holder of a live-stock export licence must not export live-stock except in accordance with the Australian Standards for the Export of Livestock (Version 2.3) 2011.

Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry (Standards) Amendment Order 2006 (No. 2)

5 Application of amendment

- (1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3), the amendment made by item 1 of Schedule 1 applies in relation to exports of live-stock from Australia on or after 25 September 2006.
- (2) The requirement contained in the Note to subparagraph (c)(i) of Standard S1.9 of the Australian Standards for the Export of Livestock (Version 2, September 2006) does not apply to cattle and buffalo from the Northern Territory sourced for export as slaughter or feeder animals until 1 January 2007.
- (3) For the period 25 September 2006 to 31 December 2006, the requirement contained in the Note at the end of Standard S1.9 of the *Australian Standards for the Export of Live-stock* published by the Department, as in force on 1 July 2005, applies to cattle and buffalo from the Northern Territory sourced for export as slaughter or feeder animals.
