### Exemption — Seat belts

---

#### **1 Commencement**

This instrument commences on the day after it is registered on the Federal Register of Legislative Instruments.

#### **2 Application**

This instrument applies to a passenger:

- (a) who is being carried as a patient on an aircraft engaged in emergency medical services; and
- (b) for whom the medical or nursing authority responsible for the carriage considers that wearing a restraint would be detrimental to his or her health.

#### **3 Exemption**

The passenger is exempt from compliance with subregulation 251 (1) of CAR 1988 (the requirement to wear a seat belt).

#### **4 Condition**

The passenger must comply with any requirement, that the pilot in command considers necessary in the interests of safety, to be restrained.
