1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Army and Air Force Canteen Service Amendment Regulations 2005 (No. 1)*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

3 Amendment of *Army and Air Force Canteen Service* Regulations 1959

Note The Finance Minister's powers under this subregulation may be delegated to an official under regulation 29.

29 Delegation by Finance Minister

- (1) The Finance Minister may, by written instrument, delegate any of the Finance Minister's powers or functions under subregulation 22 (1) to an official (within the meaning of the *Financial Management and Accountability Act 1997*).
- (2) In exercising powers or functions under a delegation, the official must comply with any directions of the Finance Minister.
