Social Security Exempt Lump Sum (Australian Capital Territory Government's Community Inclusion and Household Debt Pilot Project) (DEST) Determination 2005

Part 1 Preliminary

1 Name of determination

This determination is the *Social Security Exempt Lump Sum (Australian Capital Territory Government's Community Inclusion and Household Debt Pilot Project) (DEST) Determination 2005*.

2 Commencement

This determination commences on 23 March 2005.

3 Interpretation

In this determination:

Act means the *Social Security Act 1991*.

Australian Capital Territory Government's Community Inclusion and Household Debt Pilot Project means a project by that same name that promotes community inclusion, by providing intensive case management to a small number of participants who are at risk of social exclusion due to unmanageable debt levels.

Social security payment has the same meaning as in section 23 of the *Social Security Act 1991*.

Part 2 Exempt Lump Sums

4 Amount or class of amounts

- (1) Paragraph 8(11)(d) of the Act provides that the Secretary may determine that an amount or class of amounts received by a person, is an exempt lump sum.
- (2) If a person:
 - (a) has received an amount under the Australian Capital Territory Government's Community Inclusion and Household Debt Pilot Project; and
 - (b) is in receipt of a social security payment;

then the amount received by the person, under the Australian Capital Territory Government's Community Inclusion and Household Debt Pilot Project, is an exempt lump sum.

5 Application—Exempt Lump Sums

I determine that an amount, or class of amounts received by a person referred to in subclause 4(2) is an exempt lump sum for the purposes of paragraph 8(11)(d) of the Act from the date that the amount was received.
