

Medical Indemnity (Competitive Advantage Payment) Regulations 2005¹

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1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the Medical Indemnity (Competitive Advantage Payment) Regulations 2005.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

3 Definition

In these Regulations:

Act means the Medical Indemnity (Competitive Advantage Payment) Act 2005.

4 Applicable percentage

For subsection 6(1) of the Act, the percentage of 4.55% is specified for the contribution year that starts on 1 July 2005.
