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**1 Name of Regulations**

These Regulations are the *Medical Indemnity (Competitive Advantage Payment) Regulations 2005*.

**2 Commencement**

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

**3 Definition**

In these Regulations:

*Act* means the *Medical Indemnity (Competitive Advantage Payment) Act 2005*.

**4 Applicable percentage**

For subsection 6 (1) of the Act, the percentage of 4.55% is specified for the contribution year that starts on 1 July 2005.
