Citation

1. This Declaration may be cited as the Superannuation (PSS) Approved Authority Inclusion Declaration.

Commencement

2. This Declaration commences on 1 July 1995.

Interpretation

3. In this Declaration, unless the contrary intention appears: "**the Act**" means the *Superannuation Act 1990*.
