1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the Schools Assistance (Learning Together — Achievement Through Choice and Opportunity) Amendment Regulations 2006 (No. 1).

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the commencement of items 21 and 22 of Schedule 1 to the Schools Assistance (Learning Together — Achievement Through Choice and Opportunity) Amendment Act 2006.
