**1 Name of Regulations**

These Regulations are the *Schools Assistance (Learning Together — Achievement Through Choice and Opportunity) Amendment Regulations 2006 (No. 1)*.

**2 Commencement**

These Regulations commence on the commencement of items 21 and 22 of Schedule 1 to the *Schools Assistance (Learning Together — Achievement Through Choice and Opportunity) Amendment Act 2006*.

**3 Amendment of *Schools Assistance (Learning Together — Achievement Through Choice and Opportunity) Regulations 2005***
