1. Name of Order

This Order is the Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry (Standards) Amendment Order 2006 (No. 1).

2. Commencement

This Order commences on 25 September 2006.

3. Amendments of Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry (Standards) Order 2005

Schedule 1 amends the Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry (Standards) Order 2005.

4. Application of amendment

(1) Subject to subsection (2), the amendment made by item 1 of Schedule 1 applies in relation to exports of live-stock from Australia on or after 25 September 2006. (2) In the application, on or after 25 September 2006, of the amendment made by item 1 of Schedule 1 in relation to cattle from the Northern Territory exported as slaughter or feeder animals, subparagraph (c)(i) of Standard S1.9 of the *Australian Standards for the Export of Livestock*, as in force on that date, is taken not to be in force until 1 January 2007.
