1 Name of Determination

This Determination is the Financial Management and Accountability Determination 2006/73 — Australian Customs Service – Security Deposits Account Variation and Abolition 2006.

2 Commencement

This Determination commences at the time at which subsection 22 (4) of the *Financial Management and Accountability Act 1997* is complied with.

Note This Determination takes effect in accordance with section 22 of the *Financial Management and Accountability Act 1997*. The Parliament must consider the Determination before it can take effect, and either House may pass a resolution disallowing the Determination. If neither House passes such a resolution, the Determination takes effect on the day immediately after the last day upon which such a resolution could have been passed.

3 Variation

Schedule 1 varies the determination entitled *Initial Determination to Establish Components of the Reserved Money Fund* which established, among others, the Australian Customs Service – Security Deposits Account.

4 Abolition

The Australian Customs Service – Security Deposits Account is abolished with effect from the time at which:

- (a) Schedule 1 has taken effect; and
- (b) the balance of the appropriation for the Australian Customs Service Security Deposits Account reaches zero.
