1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *National Health Amendment Regulations 2007 (No. 2)*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence:

- (a) if they are registered before the *Private Health Insurance Act 2007* commences — on the commencement of that Act; or
- (b) if they are registered after that Act commences — on the day after they are registered.

3 Amendment of *National Health Regulations 1954*

Schedule 1 amends the *National Health Regulations 1954*.
