

Australian Securities and Investments Commission
Corporations Act 2001 — Paragraph 1020F(1)(c) — Variation

Enabling legislation

1. The Australian Securities and Investments Commission makes this instrument under paragraph 1020F(1)(c) the *Corporations Act 2001* (the *Act*).

Title

2. This instrument is ASIC Class Order [CO 07/123].

Commencement

3. This instrument commences on the later of:
 - (a) the date it is registered under the *Legislative Instruments Act 2003*; and
 - (b) 1 April 2007.

Variation

4. ASIC Class Order [CO 05/683] is varied by:
 - (a) in the note under paragraph 3 omitting “*Instrument Act*” and substituting “*Instruments Act*”;
 - (b) omitting paragraph 4 and substituting:
 - “4. Part 7.9 of the Act applies in relation to a general insurance product as if subregulation 7.9.15A(2) of the *Corporations Regulations 2001* were modified or varied by omitting “1 January 2005” and substituting “30 June 2008.”; and
 - (c) in paragraph 5 omitting the definitions of *deposit product*, *facility* and *makes non-cash payments*.
