1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Health Insurance (Pathology Services Table) Amendment Regulations 2007 (No. 1).*

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence:

- (a) if they are registered before the *Private Health Insurance Act 2007* commences — on the commencement of that Act; or
- (b) if they are registered after that Act commences on the day after they are registered.

3 Amendment of Health Insurance (Pathology Services Table) Regulations 2006
