1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Primary Industries (Customs) Charges Amendment Regulations 2007 (No. 3)*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on 1 July 2007.

Schedule 5 Deer

(regulation 5)

1 Rate of charge

For paragraph 3 (1) (a) of Schedule 5 to the Customs Charges Act, the rate of charge specified is:

- (a) from 1 July 2007 to 30 June 2010 (inclusive) — \$5 per head of live deer; and
- (b) from 1 July 2010 — \$7.75 per head of live deer.

Schedule 6 Deer Velvet

(regulation 5)

1 Rate of charge

For paragraph 3 (1) (a) of Schedule 6 to the Customs Charges Act, the rate of charge specified is:

- (a) from 1 July 2007 to 30 June 2010 (inclusive) — 2% of the declared value of deer velvet; and
- (b) from 1 July 2010 — 3.5% of the declared value of deer velvet.
