1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Corporations Amendment Regulations* 2007 (No. 7).

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence as follows:

- (a) on 1 July 2007 regulations 1 to 3 and Schedule 1;
- (b) on the commencement of the *Corporations Legislation Amendment (Simpler Regulatory System) Act 2007*—regulation 4 and Schedule 2.
