

# Customs (Narcotics Inquiries) Repeal Regulations 2007<sup>1</sup>

## 1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Customs (Narcotics Inquiries)* Repeal Regulations 2007.

#### 2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

#### 3 Repeal

The Customs (Narcotics Inquiries) Regulations 1980 are repealed.
