

# Building and Construction Industry Improvement Amendment Regulations 2007 (No. 2)<sup>1</sup>

# 1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Building and Construction Industry Improvement Amendment Regulations* 2007 (No. 2).

#### 2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

## 3 Amendment of Building and Construction Industry Improvement Regulations 2005

Schedule 1 amends the *Building and Construction Industry Improvement Regulations* 2005.

# Schedule 1 Amendments

(regulation 3)

# [1] **Subregulation 4.1 (2)**

substitute

- (2) It is a function to record information about the occupational health and safety performance of:
  - (a) an accredited person; and
  - (b) a person who has applied to be accredited under the *Building and Construction Industry Improvement* (Accreditation Scheme) Regulations 2005.

## [2] Subregulation 8.1A (2)

substitute

- (2) Protected information may be recorded and disclosed for the purpose of assessing the suitability of:
  - (a) an accredited person; or

(b) any person who has ever applied to be accredited under the *Building and Construction Industry Improvement* (Accreditation Scheme) Regulations 2005;

to undertake Commonwealth building work.
