**1 Name of Regulations**

These Regulations are the *Building and Construction Industry Improvement Amendment Regulations 2007 (No. 2)*.

**2 Commencement**

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

**3 Amendment of *Building and Construction Industry Improvement Regulations 2005***

Schedule 1 amends the *Building and Construction Industry Improvement Regulations 2005*.

**Schedule 1 Amendments**

(regulation 3)

**[1] Subregulation 4.1 (2)**

*substitute*

- (2) It is a function to record information about the occupational health and safety performance of:
- (a) an accredited person; and
  - (b) a person who has applied to be accredited under the *Building and Construction Industry Improvement (Accreditation Scheme) Regulations 2005*.

**[2] Subregulation 8.1A (2)**

*substitute*

- (2) Protected information may be recorded and disclosed for the purpose of assessing the suitability of:
- (a) an accredited person; or

- 
- (b) any person who has ever applied to be accredited under the *Building and Construction Industry Improvement (Accreditation Scheme) Regulations 2005*; to undertake Commonwealth building work.
