Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 Section 269A

Instrument Repealing Superseded Recovery Plans

I, PETER ROBERT GARRETT, Minister for the Environment, Heritage and the Arts:

Having adopted new recovery plans for the listed species specified below under subsection 269A(7) of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999*:

- *Maccullochella macquariensis* (Trout Cod)
- *Diuris fragrantissima* (Sunshine Diuris)
- Casuarius casuarius johnsonii (Southern Cassowary); and
- Petaurus gracilis (Mahogany Glider).

Hereby revoke, pursuant to subsection 33(3) of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901*, the following superseded Recovery Plans:

- Trout Cod Recovery Plan DNRE (1998), adopted 9 March 2001;
- Sunshine Diuris Recovery Plan DNRE (1998), adopted 9 March 2001;
- Southern Cassowary Recovery Plan QPWS (2001), adopted 5 October 2001; and
- Mahogany Glider Recovery Plan QPWS (2000), adopted 9 March 2001.

The repeal of the recovery plans will take effect on the date of signing of this instrument.
