

# Australian Prudential Regulation Authority Amendment Regulations 2008 (No. 1)<sup>1</sup>

### 1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the Australian Prudential Regulation Authority Amendment Regulations 2008 (No. 1).

### 2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

### 4A Prescription of prudential regulation framework laws

For paragraph (o) of the definition of *prudential regulation framework law* in subsection 3 (1) of the Act, the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* is prescribed for the purposes of section 56 of the Act.

### [2] Paragraph 5 (g)

substitute

- (g) for protected information or a protected document that:
  - (i) relates to:
    - (A) superannuation; or

- (B) a function or power of the Commissioner under the *First Home Saver Accounts Act 2008*; and
- (ii) is covered by at least 1 of the following Acts:
  - (A) the First Home Saver Accounts Act 2008;
  - (B) the *Retirement Savings Accounts Act 1997*;
  - (C) the Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1993;
  - (D) the Superannuation (Excluded Funds) Taxation Act 1987;

the Commissioner of Taxation;

*Note* Subsection 3 (1) of the *First Home Saver Accounts Act 2008* sets out the provisions of that Act for which the Commissioner has general administration.
