1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Australian Prudential Regulation Authority Amendment Regulations 2008 (No. 1)*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

3 Amendment of *Australian Prudential Regulation Authority Regulations 1998*

[1] Regulation 4A

substitute

4A Prescription of prudential regulation framework laws

For paragraph (o) of the definition of *prudential regulation framework law* in subsection 3 (1) of the Act, the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* is prescribed for the purposes of section 56 of the Act.

[2] Paragraph 5 (g)

substitute

(g) for protected information or a protected document that:

(i) relates to:

(A) superannuation; or

-
- (B) a function or power of the Commissioner under the *First Home Saver Accounts Act 2008*; and
- (ii) is covered by at least 1 of the following Acts:
- (A) the *First Home Saver Accounts Act 2008*;
 - (B) the *Retirement Savings Accounts Act 1997*;
 - (C) the *Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1993*;
 - (D) the *Superannuation (Excluded Funds) Taxation Act 1987*;
- the Commissioner of Taxation;

Note Subsection 3 (1) of the *First Home Saver Accounts Act 2008* sets out the provisions of that Act for which the Commissioner has general administration.
