

**Australian Securities and Investments Commission  
Corporations Act 2001 — Paragraph 1020F(1)(c) — Variation**

**Enabling legislation**

1. The Australian Securities and Investments Commission makes this instrument under paragraph 1020F(1)(c) of the *Corporations Act 2001* (the *Act*).

**Title**

2. This instrument is ASIC Class Order [CO 08/801].

**Commencement**

3. This instrument commences on the date it is registered under the *Legislative Instruments Act 2003*.

4. Notional section 1020BD of the Act as set out in paragraph 4 of ASIC Class Order [CO 08/751] is varied by omitting paragraph (5)(b) and substituting:
  - “(b) being issued with securities or products on the conversion of a convertible security or convertible product.”.
