

FMA Act Determination 2009/04 — Section 32 (Transfer of Functions from DEEWR to DIISR)

Financial Management and Accountability Act 1997

I, Tim Youngberry, Division Manager, Financial Reporting and Cash Management Division, Department of Finance and Deregulation, make this Determination under subsection 32 (2) of the *Financial Management and Accountability Act 1997* (the *FMA Act*).

1 Name of Determination

2 Commencement

3 Amendment of Appropriation Act (No. 1) 2008–2009

Schedule 1 amends the *Appropriation Act (No. 1) 2008–2009* to transfer an amount of \$75,000.00 of the departmental item for the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations to the departmental item for the Department of Innovation, Industry, Science and Research.

Note The amount transferred relates to the transfer of Science, Research and Innovation programs.
