1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Extradition (Safety of United Nations and Associated Personnel) Amendment Regulations 2009 (No. 1).*

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

3 Amendment of *Extradition* (Safety of United Nations and Associated Personnel) Regulations 2000

Schedule 1 amends the *Extradition* (Safety of United Nations and Associated Personnel) Regulations 2000.

4 Extradition countries

For the definition of *extradition country* in section 5 of the Act, a country, or a colony, territory or protectorate of a country, for which the Convention is in force is an extradition country.
