



Extradition (Macedonia) Regulations 2009¹

1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Extradition (Macedonia) Regulations 2009*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

3 Definitions

In these Regulations:

Act means the *Extradition Act 1988*.

Macedonia means the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia.

4 Declaration that Macedonia is an extradition country

Macedonia is declared to be an extradition country.

5 Application of the Act in relation to Macedonia

For paragraph 11 (1) (b) of the Act, the Act applies to Macedonia subject to modification of paragraph 17 (2) (a) of the Act by omitting '45 days' and substituting '60 days'.
