1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Foreign States Immunities Amendment Regulations 2009 (No. 1)*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

2A Emergency prevention and management — bushfires

Section 13 of the Act does not apply to acts or omissions of the United States of America (or a separate entity of the United States of America) if those acts or omissions are carried out:

- (a) in the course of providing facilities or assistance to the Government of Australia, or the Government of an Australian State or Territory; and
- (b) for the purpose of preparing for, preventing or managing bushfires in Australia.
