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## **1 Name of Determination**

This Determination is the *National Health (Eligible midwives) Determination 2010*.

## **2 Commencement**

This Determination commences on the later of the following:

- (a) 1 July 2010;
- (b) the day after it is registered.

## **3 Definitions**

In this Determination:

*Act* means the *National Health Act 1953*.

**National Law** means the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law set out in the Schedule to the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law Act 2009* (Qld).

**Nursing and Midwifery Board** means the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia established under section 31 of the National Law.

#### 4 Eligibility requirements

For subsection 84AAE (3) of the Act, a midwife must meet any registration standard for an eligible midwife developed by the Nursing and Midwifery Board for subsection 38 (2) of the National Law.

*Note* Subsection 38 (2) deals with developing registration standards about matters for health practitioners.
