PMTS Class C means a Public Mobile Telecommunications Service Class C, being a service that consists of 1 or more stations that:

- (a) are located on an aircraft and:
- (b) are operated under a PTS licence; and
- (c) are operated on a frequency, or frequencies, specified in a PTS licence.
