

FMA Act Determination 2010/13 — Section 32 (Transfer of Functions from FaHCSIA to DHS)

Financial Management and Accountability Act 1997

I, Hawari Badri, Acting First Assistant Secretary, Financial Reporting and Cash Management Division, Department of Finance and Deregulation, make this Determination under subsection 32(2) of the *Financial Management and Accountability Act 1997* (the *FMA Act*).

This Determination is made due to a decision of the Australian Government to transfer responsibility for the Family Assistance Office from the Department of Families, Housing, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs to the Department of Human Services.

1 Name of Determination

This Determination is the FMA Act Determination 2010/13 — Section 32 (Transfer of Functions from FaHCSIA to DHS).

2 Commencement

3 Amendment of Appropriation Act (No. 1) 2009-2010

Schedule 1 amends the *Appropriation Act (No. 1) 2009-2010* to transfer an amount of \$11,566 of the departmental item for the Department of Families, Housing, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs to the departmental item for the Department of Human Services.

Note The amount transferred relates to the transfer of governance of the Family Assistance Office.
