1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the Freedom of Information (Miscellaneous Provisions) Amendment Regulations 2010 (No. 1).

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on 1 November 2010.

3 Amendment of Freedom of Information (Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations 1982

4 Principal offices

For subparagraph (b) (i) of the definition of *principal officer* in subsection 4 (1) of the Act, an office mentioned in an item in Schedule 2 is declared to be the principal office for the authority mentioned in the item.

5 Information Commissioner's annual report — giving information

For paragraph 93 (3) (a) of the Act, the following table sets out times for giving information.

Item	For	the agency or Minister must give information
1	the period beginning on 1 July 2010 and ending on 31 October 2010	by 10 December 2010
2	the period beginning on 1 November 2010 and ending on 31 December 2010	by 21 January 2011
3	a quarter beginning on or after 1 January 2011	21 days after the end of the quarter
4	the period beginning on the commencement of these Regulations and ending on 30 June 2011	by 31 July 2011
5	a financial year beginning on or after 1 July 2011	by the 31 July immediately following the end of that financial year
