



Aged Care (Residential Care Subsidy — Amount of Concessional Resident Supplement) Determination 2011 (No. 1)¹

1 Name of Determination

This Determination is the *Aged Care (Residential Care Subsidy — Amount of Concessional Resident Supplement) Determination 2011 (No. 1)*.

2 Commencement

This Determination commences on 20 March 2011.

3 Revocation

The *Aged Care (Residential Care Subsidy — Amount of Concessional Resident Supplement) Determination 2010 (No. 2)* made by the Minister on 9 September 2010, also known as F2010L02482, is revoked.

4 Definitions

In this Determination:

Act means the *Aged Care Act 1997*.

new resident has the meaning given by section 21.11B of the *Residential Care Subsidy Principles 1997*.

relevant residential care service, for a care recipient who is a concessional resident, means the residential care service that provides residential care (other than respite care) to the care recipient on a day.

5 Amount of concessional resident supplement

For subsection 44-6(4) of the Act, the amount of concessional resident supplement for a day is:

- (a) for a care recipient who is a concessional resident:
 - (i) if, on the day, more than 40% of the new residents to whom the relevant residential care service provides residential care (other than respite care) are supported residents, concessional residents or assisted residents — \$19.32; and
 - (ii) in any other case — \$12.64; and
- (b) for a care recipient who is an assisted resident — \$7.95
