# Exemption — display of markings

### 1 Duration

This instrument:

- (a) commences on the day after registration; and
- (b) stops having effect at the end of 28 February 2013.

## 2 Application

This instrument applies to all Diamond DA 42 aircraft (the *aircraft*) whose markings do not meet the minimum height, width and painting requirements of Part 45 of CASR 1998.

#### 3 Exemption

The aircraft are exempt from compliance with the requirements of regulations 45.065 and 45.070 and paragraph 45.085 (2) (c) of CASR 1998.

#### 4 Condition

The exemption is subject to the condition mentioned in Schedule 1.

## Schedule 1 Condition

Lateral markings must be displayed in accordance with the manufacturer's maintenance manual.
