accreditation application means an application to the accreditation body, under subsection 2.9 (2) of the *Accreditation Grant Principles 2011*, by the approved provider of a residential care service for re-accreditation of the service.

subsection 2.10 (1) of the *Accreditation Grant Principles 2011*.
