1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Electronic Transactions Amendment Regulations 2011 (No. 1)*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the commencement of Schedule 1 to the *Electronic Transactions Amendment Act 2011*.

3 Amendment of Electronic Transactions Regulations 2000

Schedule 1 amends the Electronic Transactions Regulations 2000.
