1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Energy Grants (Cleaner Fuels)* Scheme Amendment Regulations 2011 (No. 1).

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

3 Amendment of Energy Grants (Cleaner Fuels) Scheme Regulations 2004

Schedule 1 amends the *Energy Grants (Cleaner Fuels) Scheme Regulations* 2004.

5 Start and end days for entitlements

- (1) For paragraph 5 (1) (i) of the Act, this regulation sets out a requirement for a provisional entitlement to a cleaner fuel grant for fuel mentioned in an item of the table in subregulation (2).
- (2) The qualifying time mentioned in paragraph 5 (1) (c) of the Act must occur:
 - (a) on or after the start day mentioned in the item; and

(b) before the end day (if any) mentioned in the item.

Item	Fuel	Start day	End day
1	Biodiesel blend	18 September 2003	
2	Low sulphur PULP	1 January 2006	31 December 2007
3	Ultra low sulphur automotive diesel	1 January 2007	31 December 2008

(3) For paragraph 5 (1) (a) of the Act, the start day for fuel mentioned in an item of the table in subregulation (2) is the start day for that paragraph.
